

Early childhood social and educational partner services

The social and educational services system for the childhood is made up of:

NURSERY SCHOOL

It is a service between the ages of 3 months and 3 years. It contributes together with the families to their harmonic growth; has as its purpose the education, care, socialization of children and support for families. The modules of daily frequency of the child must not exceed 10 hours. Educational and social interest public open to all girls and all children

CENTER FOR CHILDREN

It is a service with educational, play and cultural characteristics open to all girls and all children aged between 18 months and 3 years, provides a continuous use of the service within flexible organizational modules. The center does not provides routine activities, responds to the evolutionary needs and growth of children by putting a layout carefully designed spaces and activities aimed at achieving the objectives of autonomy and construction of social rules.

CENTER FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

It is a service with educational characteristics, games, cultural and aggregating presence with which everyday deal with the care of the child. There frequency is daily social. Temporary provision for children between the ages of 3 months and 3 years and parents or other adults maximum three hours for a few days a week. The services offers to children the opportunity for growth and cognitive moles, for adults the possibility of comparison and sharing of knowledge and educational models

SPRING SECTION (integrated sections between nursery and kindergarten)

It's a service innovative socio-educational open to all girls and all children aged 24 months and 3 years aimed at encouraging of an gradual inclusion in kindergarten through the preparation of an educational context able to accommodate the first experience of socialization of the child who has never attended the nest. Inside the educational programs are scheduled specific activities for the age group and moments of common activities with older children attending nursery school
